
Things You
Should Know

- 1 It's for those who have aptitudes and interests in specific fields of study
  - Focus on course-specific aptitudes and interests
  - But, non-course-specific achievements, e.g. sports, performing arts, leadership, are also considered
    - **7** Assessed through different modes
      - E.g. interviews, aptitude tests, showcasing your portfolio, depending on the course you apply for
        - Take place before N-Level exams
          - If your child's application is successful, he/she will be given a conditional offer before he/she take the N- Level exams

- 4 Still have to meet the minimum entry requirements
  - TE: Most *Nitec* or *Higher Nitec* courses have **subject-specific** minimum entry requirements
    - Polytechnics: Minimum entry requirements for the polytechnic course (Net ELR2B2 score of 26 points or better at O-Levels)

(...or your child's offer will be revoked)

But your child won't have to compete for admission to the PSEIs strictly on the basis of how well he/she does academically compared to everyone else



\*The DAE application period varies across the five polytechnics

Support him/her to research on the courses he/she is interested in and related careers in the sector




