

Cease of 2-year Nitec courses, transition to 3-year Higher Nitec courses

ITE AY2027 (Entry Requirement for Polytechnic)

- 1. H-Nitec GPA \geq 2.5 \rightarrow Eligible to apply for Poly Yr1
- 2. H-Nitec GPA ≥ 3.5 → Guaranteed Poly Yr1




