#### **ARTS INSTITUTIONS**

# Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts (NAFA) Foundation Programme (NFP)



A one-year programme that prepares eligible N(A) students for progression into the relevant <u>NAFA diploma programme</u>.

Apply for NFP through NAFA's <u>online portal</u> (subject to meeting eligibility requirements).



Students may be required to submit a portfolio, attend an admission test or audition, and/or an interview.

#### **POLYTECHNICS**

#### Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

A one-year programme that offers eligible N(A) students a practice-based preparatory pathway to a polytechnic education at one of the five polytechnics.



Apply for PFP through the <u>PFP Admissions Exercise portal</u> (subject to meeting eligibility requirements).

To provide greater flexibility in pathways, students will be admitted to a PFP cluster, before being posted to a specific diploma. Posting will be based on their PFP performance and course choice. Find out more <a href="https://example.com/here.">here.</a>

#### INSTITUTE OF TECHNICAL EDUCATION ( ITE )

#### **Direct Entry Scheme to Polytechnic Programme (DPP)**

A two-year Higher Nitec course at ITE that enables eligible N(A) students to progress directly to a mapped polytechnic diploma course, provided they meet the qualifying GPA. Find out more <u>here</u>.

#### 3-year Higher Nitec (JIE 'N')

A three-year course offering a variety of options for all N-Level students to explore based on their strengths, interests and aspirations. Find out more <u>here</u>.

#### 4-year Higher Nitec (JIE 'E')

A four-year course for selected N-Level students that includes a one-year preparatory programme to strengthen students' literacy and numeracy skills. Find out more <u>here</u>.
