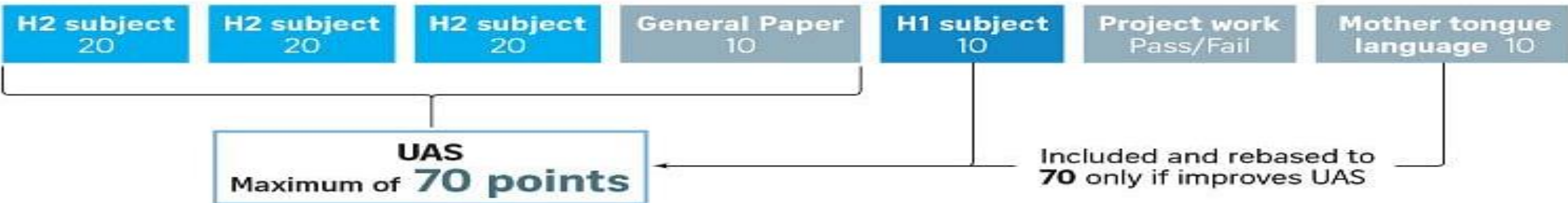

Direct School Admission (Junior College)

- allow JCs to select Secondary 4/5 students for admission to JC1 based on their achievements and talents
- provide students an opportunity to demonstrate a more diverse range of achievements and talents in seeking admission to a JC/Institution
- required to meet JC admissions criteria
- from **Jun – Aug 2024**
