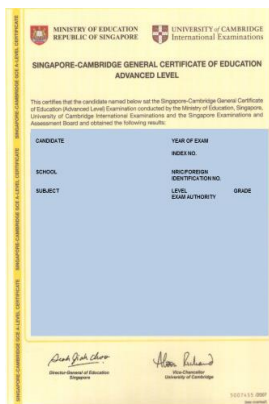

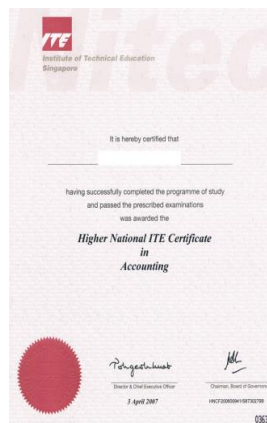

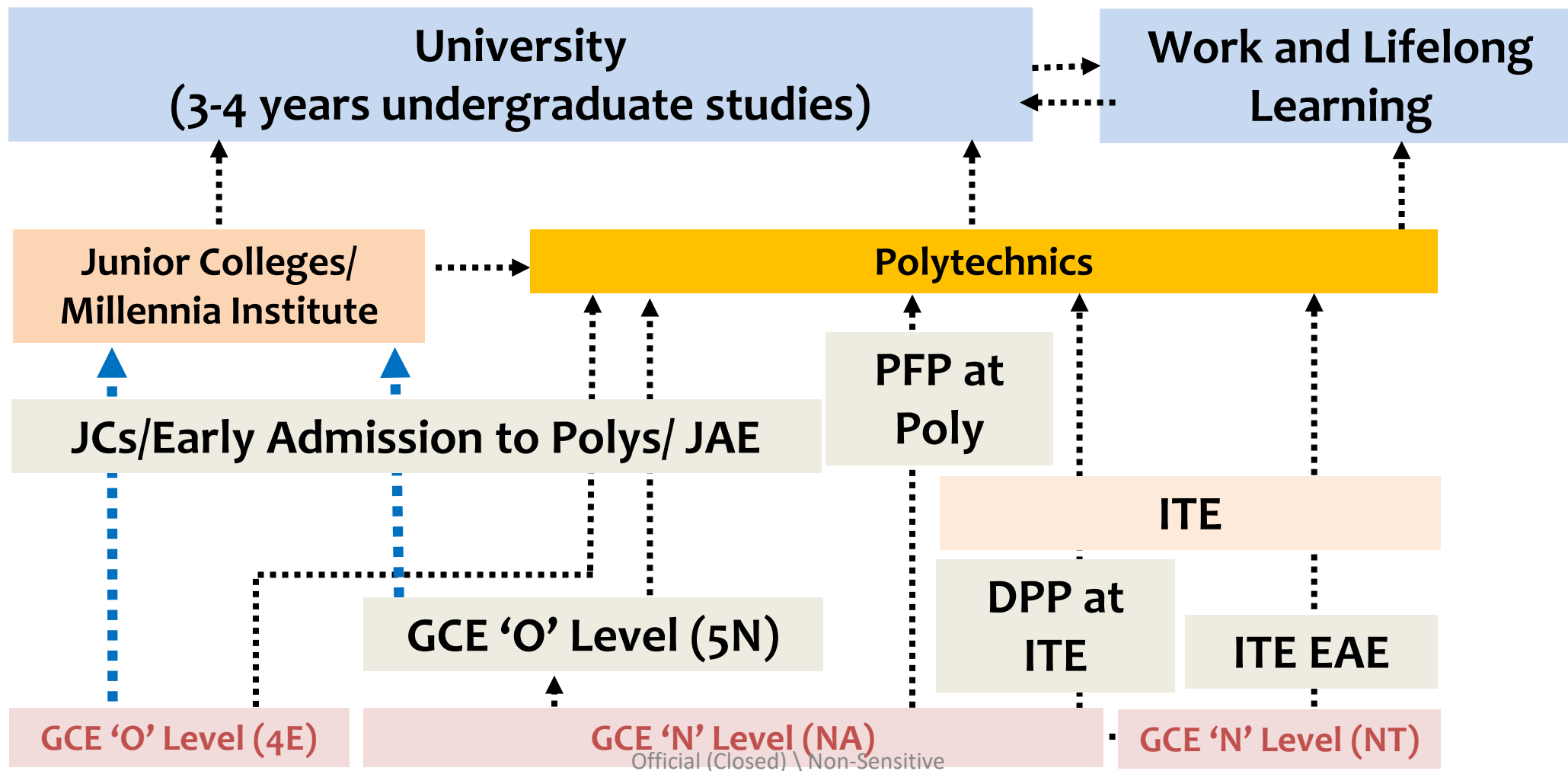

Early Admissions Exercise (EAE)

- Aptitude-based admissions exercise
- Students receive conditional offers for admission to the polytechnics based on aptitude and interest prior to receiving final grades
- Application via <https://www.moe.gov.sg/post-secondary/admissions> in **June 2024/2025**

Polytechnic (Express and 5NA)

BEFORE **GCE 'O' Level**

Early Admissions Exercise (EAE)

- Must satisfy the following
 - a **net ELR2B2 score of 26 points or better** for the GCE 'O' Level Examination; and
 - **Minimum Entry Requirements** (MER) for the selected polytechnic course

AFTER GCE 'O' Level

Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE)

- Main admissions exercise for GCE 'O' Level graduates
- Admissions **based on net ELR2B2 'O' Level aggregate score** minus CCA Bonus Points
- Application **upon release of GCE 'O' Level results in January 2025/2026**

1	For students seeking admission to JC/MI/Polytechnic/ITE and with the following co-curricular attainments/grades: a. Excellent, A1 – A2 b. Good, B3 – C6	2 points 1 point	Limited to a maximum of 4 Bonus Points for these 4 types.	Limited to a maximum of 6 Bonus Points .
2	For students seeking admission to JC/MI courses and with grades of A1 to C6 in both their first languages (i.e. English and a Higher Mother Tongue).	2 points		
3	For students seeking admission to JC/MI courses and with grades of A1 to C6 in Malay/Chinese (Special Programme) (MSP/CSP) or Bahasa Indonesia (BI) as their third language.	2 points		
4	For students from feeder schools if they choose their affiliated Junior College course(s) as their: a. 1 st choice, <u>or</u> b. 1 st and 2 nd choices.	2 points		
5	For students who have applied for the CLEP, MLEP or TLEP and have been selected for the programme.	2 points

Early Childhood Development (NP)	8 to 21

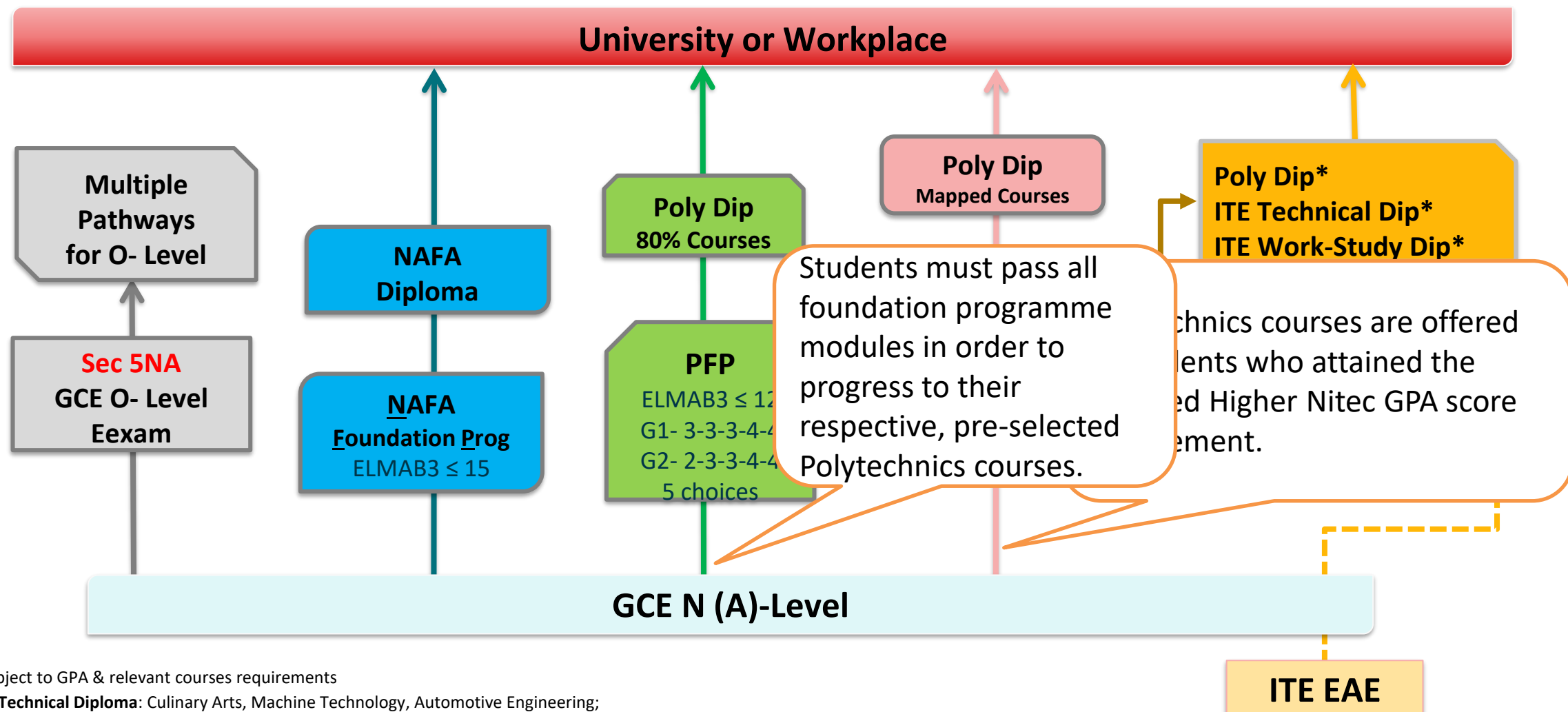

Placement is subject to the availability of vacancies and in open competition with other eligible applicants based on merit.

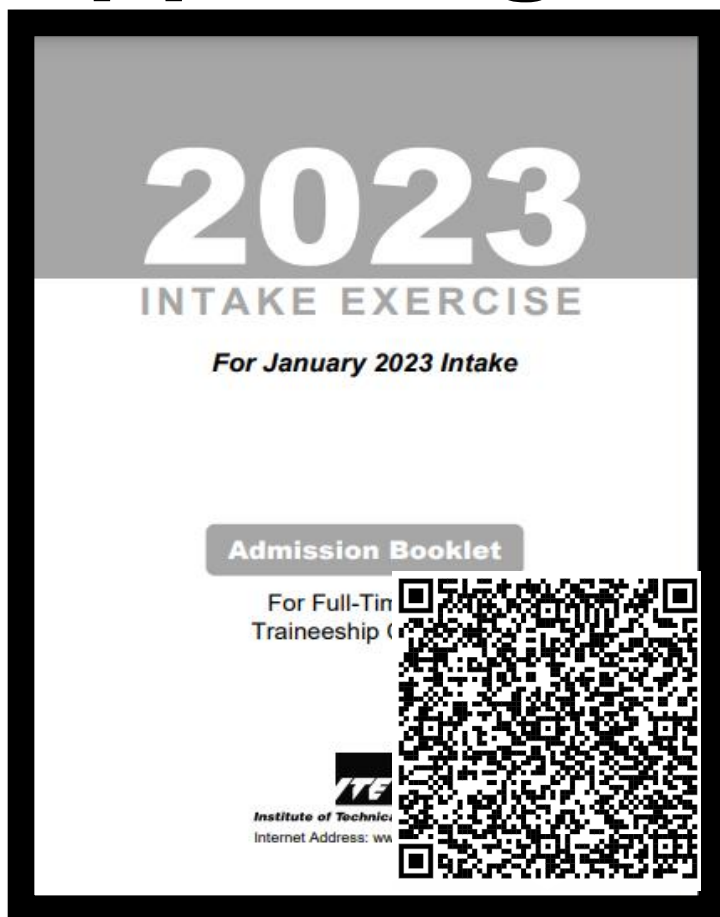
