Poly Early Admissions Exercise (EAE)

- Aptitude-based admissions exercise
- Students receive <u>conditional offers</u> for admission to the polytechnics based on aptitude and interest prior to receiving final grades
- Application via <u>https://www.moe.gov.sg/post-secondary/admissions</u> in <u>June 2024</u>

- Admissions <u>based on net ELR2B2 'O' Level aggregate</u> <u>score</u> (minus CCA Bonus Points)
- Application <u>upon release of GCE 'O' Level results in</u> January 2025





What is the Early Admissions Exercise (EAE) about?



- Opportunity to seek admission to the post secondary education institutes (ITE, Polytechnics and JCs) before N and O level examinations
- Based on a diverse range of academic and nonacademic achievements talents, aptitude and interest













Types of Early Admissions Exercises

Things You Should Know

- **1** It's for those who have *aptitudes* and *interests* in specific fields of study
 - Focus on **course-specific aptitudes and interests**
 - But, non-course-specific achievements, e.g. sports, performing arts, leadership, are also considered
 - Assessed through different modes
 - E.g. interviews, aptitude tests, showcasing your portfolio, depending on the course you apply for



Take place before O -Level exams


 If your child's application is successful, he/she will be given a conditional offer before he/she take the O- Level exams



- **4** Still have to meet the minimum entry requirements
 - **Polytechnics:** Minimum entry requirements for the polytechnic course (Net ELR2B2 score of **26 points or better** at O-Levels)
 - Junior Colleges: Gross L1R5 score of 20 and better at O-Levels
- (...or your child's offer will be revoked)

5 But your child won't have to compete for admission to the PSEIs strictly on the basis of how well he/she does academically compared to everyone else


