

# Requirements for admission

	Poly Foundation Programme (PFP)	Direct-entry- scheme to Poly Programme (DPP)	ITE
Duration of course	1 year PFP + 3 years Poly	2 years Higher Nitec + 2 years Poly	3 years Higher Nitec
Aggregate score required	EMB3 ≤ 12	EMB3 ≤ 19	Based on 4 subjects

1	EL	English Language
2	MA	Mathematics / Additional Mathematics
3 to 5	B3	Best 3 other subjects



# 3NT - Calculation of Aggregate Score (ITE)

No.	Best 4	Subject Category
		Course dependent
1 to 4	Best 4	Usually either English Language / Mathematics / Science is a compulsory subject

# 2025 Sec 3 Subjects Requirements
