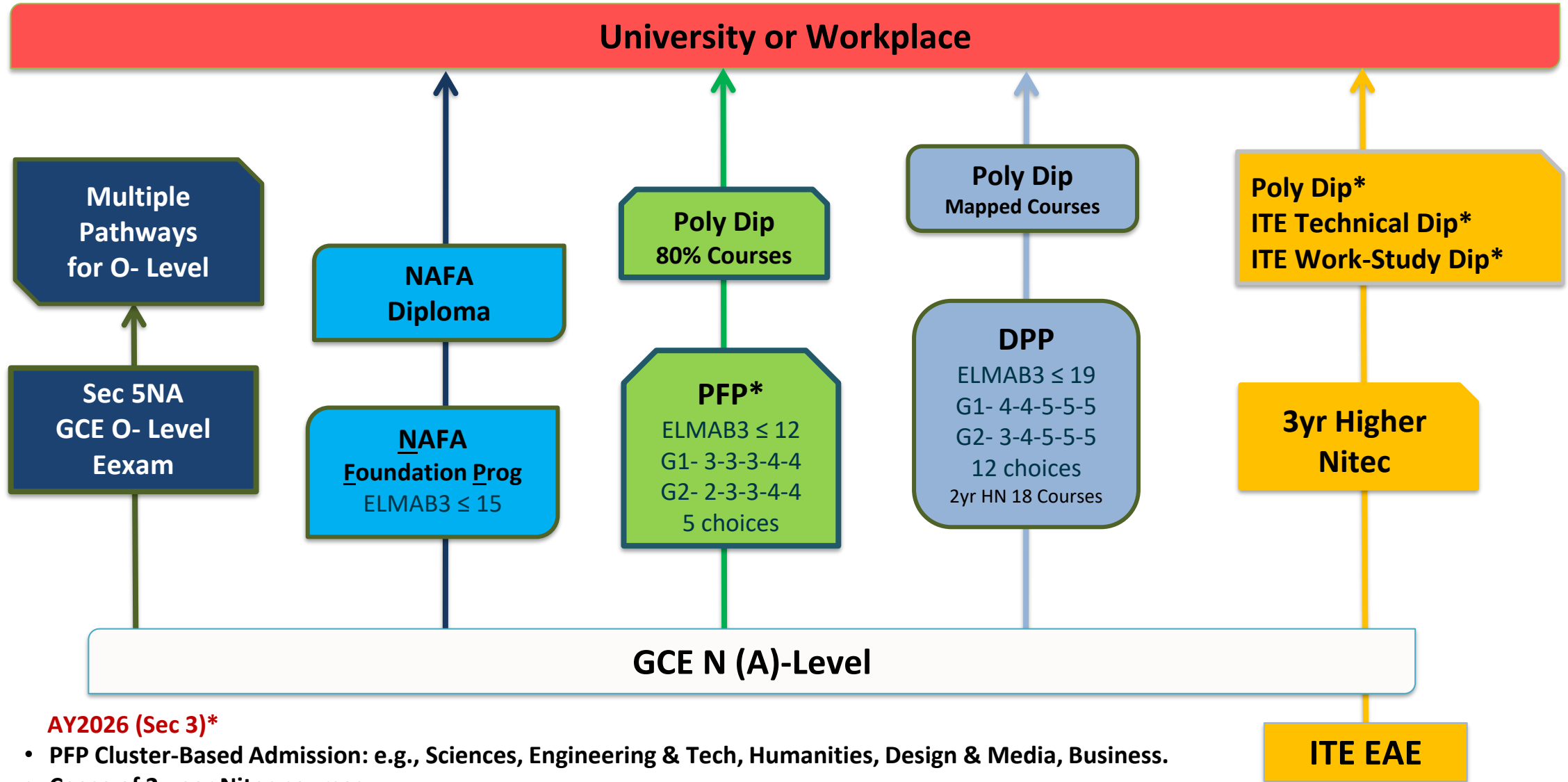

Post-Secondary Options

For Pupils on the *Normal (Academic) course*,

4 options

using GCE 'N' level results

a) Sec 5 GCE 'O' Level
Programme

b) Polytechnic Foundation
Programme (PFP) at Poly

Promoted to Sec 5N(A)

(a) **ELMAB3** (English Language, Mathematics and best three other subjects) of 19 points or less; and

(b) at least an **N(A)-level grade 5** for all subjects used in the computation of ELMAB3

Minimum Requirement

- Must satisfy the following

Cease of 2-year Nitec courses, transition to 3-year Higher Nitec courses

ITE AY2027 (Entry Requirement for Polytechnic)

1. H-Nitec GPA ≥ 2.5 \rightarrow Eligible to apply for Poly Yr1
2. H-Nitec GPA ≥ 3.5 \rightarrow Guaranteed Poly Yr1
