SERVICE LEADERSHIP PROGRAMME

All students on the Service Leadership Programme will learn the knowledge, skills and values needed for them to become leaders who rally others in carrying out impactful community projects. With this, they will empower the less fortunate, helping the vulnerable in society to become more self-reliant. Students will get a chance to lead and initiate projects across different Values-in-Action (VIA) platforms in the school. Some of these platforms include:



AGENCY AND ADVOCACY

The programme for Lower Secondary focuses on Agency, where students initiate projects that create significant impacts to improve the lives of others. In Upper Secondary, our focus on Advocacy allows students to lead and gather support to represent the 'voice for the voiceless' in community forums and dialogues.



Project COMPassion

Students of JSS initiate community-based projects to benefit the less fortunate among the residents of Taman Jurong and beyond. They will embark on a journey of heightened awareness, advocacy and activism as advocates who make a difference to the lives of others, and act on the belief that they can make a positive impact in their community.

JSS-TJ Elderly Befrienders Programme

Our students work in teams to visit elderly residents in Taman Jurong, instilling in our students the core values of graciousness and gratitude. Students on the Service Leadership Programme will lead their peers to reflect on their experiences with the elderly residents and design meaningful activities with the residents.

Citi-YMCA Youth For Causes (YFC)

Started by Citi Foundation and the YMCA of Singapore in 2003, the programme is a catalyst to promote social entrepreneurship and community leadership development among Singapore youths. Students, in teams of four, will have the opportunity to undergo training and volunteer mentorship for executing self-initiated projects to raise public awareness, funds and mobilise volunteers for Social Service organisations of their choice.

SCIENCE (SCoRe)

JSS SCIENCE COMMUNICATIONS & RESEARCH PROGRAMME

RESEARCH PROGRAMME

Students participate in different research opportunities within and outside Singapore.
